EXT. DAY - IN THE BAY ON A BOAT

Captain Colin is driving his boat, calm and collected, going about his daily routine. He passes by other boaters and their boats and starts to think to himself.

CAPTAIN COLIN (V.O.)

I know my Port from Starboard...

Cut to a shot of two amateur boaters. The Spotter sees another boat approaching on their right-hand side.

DRIVER

Talk to me, are we good?!

SPOTTER

Oncoming on the Starboard side!

The Driver immediately starts turning to the right, straight into harm's way.

SPOTTER

NO! YOUR OTHER STARBOARD!

Cut to a shot of the two men yelling as the Driver tries to quickly turn the boat to the left. Cut back to Captain Colin driving.

CAPTAIN CLICHÉ (O.S.)

Hello there, fellow Captain!

Captain Colin looks over to where the voice came from. Cut to a shot of a man in really cliché boating attire, complete with a captain's hat with the tag still hanging off the back. The man has a crazy big smile and is waving exuberantly at Captain Colin. We tilt down to reveal the fenders of the boat still out. Rookie move.

Cut to Captain Colin turning away and shaking his head wearily.

CAPTAIN COLIN (V.O.)

I know to pull my fenders in...

Cut to a wide shot of the boat, Captain Colin is pulling into a pump out dock. Cut to a shot of Captain Colin attaching the pump as he looks to camera breaking the 4th wall.

CAPTAIN COLIN

I own my ship. Dump at the pump.

Cut to wide outro shot of Captain Colin waiting by the pump looking effortlessly cool. Graphics pop on screen.

EXT. DAY - FREE PUMP OUT STATION (POSSIBLE:15)

Wide shot of Captain Colin, standing around clearly irritated. Cut to a close up of Captain Colin, he simply states: "Keep that y-valve locked. Use a zip tie." Cut to a wide shot of Captain Colin, "Boating Tips with Captain Colin" pops on screen, while Captain Colin tries to remove his lav mic, clearly done with this video nonsense.
